

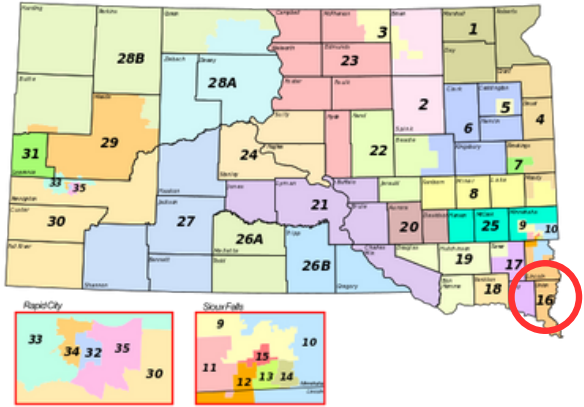


Legislative District 16

Kindergarten Immunization Rates in South Dakota

High immunization rates protect South Dakota's children from catching contagious diseases that can be prevented with routine vaccinations. For example, **95% of the community must be immunized** to prevent an outbreak of measles. When rates drop below this safe threshold, we're all at risk.

2022-23 Statewide MMR Immunization Average

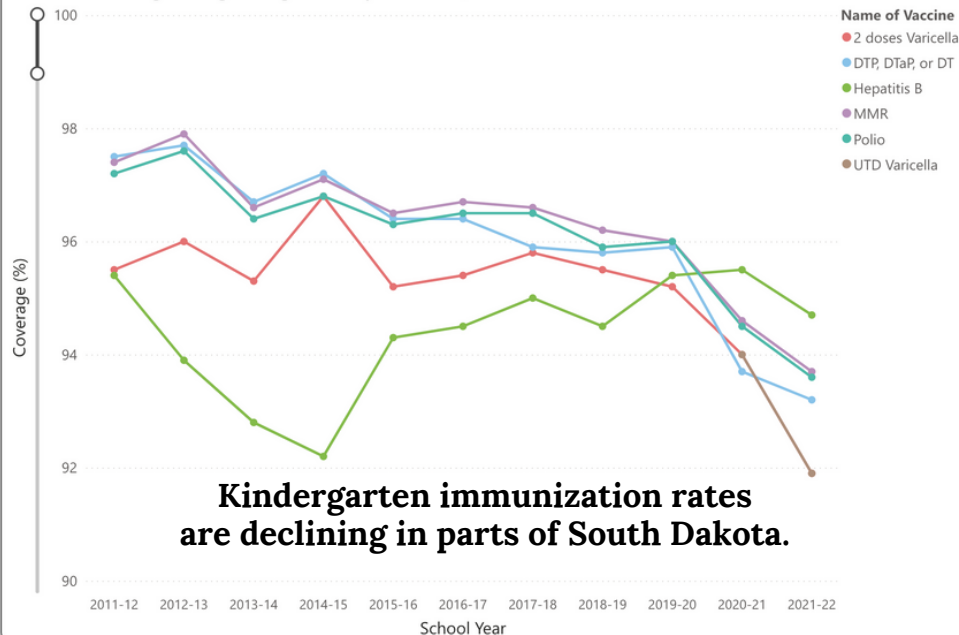
